## Suggested Items to Bring With You on Move-In Day

Please keep in mind the following list is intended as a general overview. Each assisted living facility is different, so it is very important to talk with the facility in advance and verify their specific guidelines or policies.

### Documents needed for admission paperwork

- Medicare and/or Medicaid Card
- Long-term care insurance card, prescription coverage, or supplement plans
- DNR documents, living will and/or Power of Attorney documents
- Emergency contact information
- Funeral home information / burial information

### Furniture

- Bed (including pillow(s), sheets, comforter, blanket, mattress pad, etc.)
- Nightstand and dresser
- Lamps
- T.V.
- Love seat and/or arm chair
- Dining table with chairs

### Kitchenette

- Kitchen towels, washcloths and towel rack
- Snacks
- Dishes, silverware and dish soap
- Wastebasket
- Ask in advance if the following items are allowed: toasters, toaster ovens, hot plates, coffee makers, etc.

### Bathroom

- Towels and washcloths
- Bathing items (shampoo, soap, shaving items, etc.)
- Hand soap/ Soap dish
- Wastebasket
- Incontinence Products, wet wipes, Kleenex & other personal toiletries

### Miscellaneous

- Hangers
- Alarm Clock and Radio
- Laundry Soap / laundry basket or hamper
