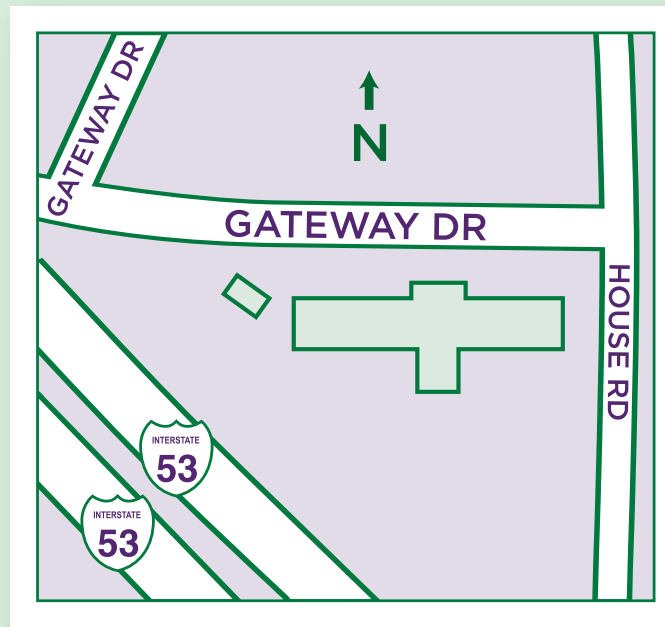
Memory Care

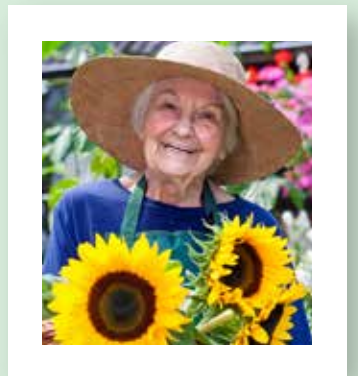
Our philosophy
